
Globe Ball Decorations



This is a fun decoration to make! Add thread or ribbon and hang on your Christmas tree. Make a few ranging in colours and put them in a bowl for a great coffee table decoration or put them over fairy lights for a fantastic party accessory... this Globe Ball is so versatile.


1: Print out the Globe ball template onto your chosen paper and cut out around the solid lines.

NOTE: Pattern is at A4 size, but can be photocopied or enlarged onto larger paper if you wish.
You will need to print pattern on opposite side of paper to prevent visible lines on your final Globe.



2: Fold circle-


With the print lines facing upwards, fold outwards along the dotted lines, to create a triangle. This prevents visible lines on your globe. It is best to fold you lines using a ruler, this way you will get a straighter edge and more perfect globe



3: Create the top and bottom of your Globe-

Using 5 circles, glue flaps together. Keeping the point of the triangles at the top as shown. Glue together the first and last flaps to create a the top. This should make half a dome as image shows.


Repeat step 3 to create bottom of Globe.



4: Create Middle Band:

With the remaining 10 pieces, glue flaps together. This time alternate the triangle points to be at the top, then bottom, as shown.

Glue the first and last flaps together to make a band.



5: Form Ball:

Glue Globe top section to the middle band then do the same with the bottom.

Make multiples and string together or place in a large bowl for a great table decoration.

NOTE: The pattern fits 2 inch circle cutters.
